Your child's learning and development is observed regularly by their key person. The observations are recorded on our school ipads which enables us to share them with you by email.

By simply replying to the emails we send you, you have a fantastic opportunity to share with us any comments you may have about the observations. You can also add comments about what your child has been achieving at home.

Each observation has a next step, individually tailored to extend your child's development. It would be great if you could look at these at home too. Remember to let us know if they are achieving them or if you are working on some of your own.

Don't forget to provide the school with the email addresses you would like the Learning Journeys to be sent to. You will receive an initial email to register. If you do not receive an email from us please check your junk folder or speak to a member of staff.

Polite reminders...

Please label all of your child's belongings with their name e.g. jumpers, bags, water bottles and even shoes. We acquire a lot of lost property and are not able to return it to its rightful owners, as it is not named.
