Music Vision

Music is for every child and every voice is heard.

At Inglewood Nursery and Infant school, we aim to provide an inclusive, accessible and enjoyable music education for all our learners. Our vision for the teaching and learning of music ensures that every child adopts a lifelong love of music and is excited to take part in musical experiences at their own stage of development.

Music is fully embedded in every curriculum area and is part of all aspects of our school life. We offer clubs, performances and the opportunities to experience live music on a weekly basis.

Music is taught following the New Creative Charanga Musical School Scheme, which is aligned with the EYFS Framework and National Curriculum for Music (KS1). Teachers also adapt their planning with their learners' interests at heart, using songs and rhymes from Charanga and the Little Wandle Phonics Scheme.

As our learners practise their skills and develop their knowledge in music, we also encourage their creativity and imagination. Our learners take part in musical experiences during a weekly singing assembly with a music specialist, where they develop performance skills which they use during class assemblies and yearly celebrations to which their parents and carers are invited. .

Oracy Development

Music enhances the development of our learners oracy skills as they work collaboratively with their peers. Learning takes place through structured music lessons as well as practise opportunities for exploration with instruments in continuous provision across the classrooms and during regular performance opportunities.

Rights Respecting Schools Approach

We aim to support a Rights Respecting Schools approach to the teaching and learning of music. A Rights Respecting approach ensures that every child can succeed regardless of their background. We intend to provide a music curriculum where every child's voice is valued, a curriculum that provides a deep understanding for all and where every learner's knowledge and skills are enhanced. Child's voice is regularly viewed and acted upon to support our learners to enjoy their music experiences.

Inclusivity

We celebrate the different cultures, languages and backgrounds of our learners through songs and musical activities. We make music accessible to everyone, including learners with diverse learning needs and abilities in many ways. For example we provide adapted instruments and quiet spaces to learn. We adjust pace and repetition to ensure all learners experience success and are proud of their musical achievements.
