<u>Objectives</u>	Use line, shape and tone in drawings with pencil, charcoal and pastels. Select a particular type of pencil (graded) to create a desired effect. Make observational drawings.	Mix and match colours. Develop different techniques to apply paint and use these, as well as knowledge of colour in artwork to express mood.	Relief printing and printing block design. Compare own image and pattern making with work of William Morris. Design and print own Christmas cards.	Create collages featuring different materials. Explain choices of materials. Use collage to illustrate interpretations of music, literature etc.	Make a clay mug with advancing techniques – rolling, joining, smoothing, cutting. Explore shaping.
