Attendance

Parents have legal responsibility to ensure their child attends school regularly. Regular school attendance is essential for every child and young person. In exceptional circumstances, the Local Authority may issue a Fixed Penalty Notice. This may apply where there is evidence to suggest that a parent or carer is deliberately manipulating attendance patterns to avoid enforcement action.

We understand that circumstances can vary, and our aim is always to work in partnership with families to support good attendance. If you are experiencing difficulties that may affect your child's attendance, we encourage you to speak to your child's class teacher or the school office.

As good practice, we will now inform you of weekly overall attendance on every Thursday Thoughts.
