The successful candidate:

- Will be enthusiastic and have a nurturing, positive and proactive approach
- Will have a specific Early Years Qualification at Level 3 that can be counted in staff: child ratios, and a GCSE English and Maths at grade C / 4 or above (or equivalent)
- Will be able to positively promote the progress, aspirations and well-being of young learners
- Will be able to fulfil key person responsibilities for a group of learners
- Will share responsibility with colleagues for creating an environment where all children can interact and develop physically, socially, intellectually and creatively through play
- Will provide learning experiences that will challenge and enable our young learners to develop confidence and independence
- Will take responsibility for a group of learners -including observations, assessments, monitoring, record-keeping and using these to inform planning, adapting
- Will be flexible and able to manage change within a varied daily working environment
- Will understand their role and responsibilities in safeguarding children
- Will have a commitment to continued professional development

The role will include:

- Working within our wraparound and / or early education units with children aged between 9 months and 2 years
- Using Birth to Five, in-the-moment planning, and adult-led provocations to meet children's individual needs in all areas of learning
- Using effective communication strategies to support the engagement and independence of all learners
- Fulfilling responsibilities and complying with policies and procedures relating to safeguarding, confidentiality, data protection, inclusion and equality
- Providing personal care, supporting healthy eating and using our outdoor environment daily
- Other duties as needed to ensure that our children and their families are at the centre of all we do – everyone matters
